Workshop on Intra-State Peace and Security

21-23 November 2018 at the University of Mannheim

Organized by Prof. Sabine Carey Funded by the ERC Project 336019

At this workshop we aim to discuss ongoing research projects on intra-state peace and security, with specific focus on how political violence escalates, deescalates, or does not escalate despite adverse conditions, such as in post-war societies. We are especially interested in work that assesses the nature and role of state institutions (including security forces) and civil society (particularly the media) in advancing or corrupting peace and the respect for human rights. We invite presentations and papers on questions such as how the role and legitimacy of the security forces and former warring parties changed in post-war settings, how institutions were modified to deal with political dissent and how citizens evaluate and trust political actors in (previously) volatile conditions.
